NO OBJECTION CERTIFICATE



The board headed by the Station Officer Fire and Rescue Station Aroor, has inspected the Educational Building height 11.70 mtr(G+2), in survey No. 219/11,12,13,14,34,5/1,5/2,5/3,3/1,4,31B,31A of Ezhupunna Village in Alappuzha district under Ezhupunna Grama panchayath owned by Sri. Procurator, Fr. Gasper, Peruveli, Bishop's House Fort Kochi. and recommended to renew the No Objection Certificate NoC.5224/19 dated 05.11.2019 of The District Fire Officer, Fire and Rescue Services, Alappuzha for the occupation of the said building as per the minutes prepared by the board.

In the circumstances this No Objection Certificate is issued under my seal and authority for the continued occupation of the above building. No further construction will be allowed in the vacant spaces provided in the approved plan.

This Certificate is issued on the condition that the fire fighting system installed will be kept always functional and the owner of the building should take special care to maintain the system installed in proper working condition. This certificate is valid for one year from the date of issue. After one year this certificate must be renewed. Non renewal of the certificate within the time limit will result in loss of eligibility for insurance coverage and appropriate legal action by the local self government/Revenue Department. All officers of and above rank of station officer of Fire and Rescue Department will have the right to inspect the building any day time after serving 7 days notice to ensure that the installed systems are in good working condition.

This No Objection Certificate pertains only to the Fire Fighting arrangements installed in the building. The Civil Construction shall be got inspected and approved by the appropriate local authority.
